Risen

In this 2016 movie, Ralph Fiennes portrays Clavius, a Roman Tribune who is appointed by Pontius Pilate to investigate the rumors of a risen Jewish Messiah. Pilate orders him to locate the missing body of Yeshua. In doing so, Pilate seeks to quell an imminent uprising in Jerusalem during the first 40 days following Christ's crucifixion. Failing to secure Yeshua's body, Clavius attempts to locate his disciples for clues to his disappearance.
